

TCS Driver Agreement

In order for staff, parents and volunteers to transport students to and from The Children's School of Oak Park activities, all volunteers and TCS staff must meet the following requirements.

- Provide a copy of a motor vehicle report by going online [here](http://www.ilsos.gov) (www.ilsos.gov) or the current state of the individual.
- Provide a copy of proof of insurance card.
- Confirm adequate personal insurance limits below:
 - The owner-operator must carry their own liability insurance on their private automobile- minimum \$100,000 per person/\$300,000 per accident.
 - Driver must provide a copy of proof of insurance.
- Confirm appropriate passenger restraint system available for and used by each passenger. Students 12 years old and younger must ride in back seats with shoulder belts. Students older than 12 may ride in the front seat with a shoulder belt per Illinois Child Passenger Safety Requirements.
- The owner-operator must possess a valid U. S. driver's license.
- The owner-operator's insurance is primary.
- The vehicle used to transport students is in safe operating condition.

By signing, the owner-operator signifies that they carry a minimum of \$100,000 per person and \$300,000 per accident liability insurance, are at least twenty five (25) years of age, hold a valid U. S. driver's license, and will transport students according to state and federal law in a vehicle that is in safe operating condition.
